

VIDEO: HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR VIDEOS TO YOUTUBE! CHEAT SHEET



WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Device

- You can upload to YouTube from any Android or Apple Device, including iPhones, iPads, Tablets, Macbooks and PC Computers.
- Use which ever device your video is stored on to easily upload the video to YouTube.

Edited Video

- Once you've exported your video from your editing software, watch your video all the way through to check for any errors or inconsistencies.
- Save a back up of your final video to your Hard Drive or Cloud Storage for future use.

Reliable Internet Connection

- You'll need a strong internet connection to upload videos to YouTube and depending on the length and size of your video, the upload time can vary from minutes to hours. Just be prepared to wait.




YOUTUBE ACCOUNT

To upload a video to YouTube, you will need a YouTube account. These are free to set up.

How to set up YouTube Account:

1. Open an internet browser and go to www.youtube.com
2. In the top right hand corner, there's an option to "sign in" - click that option.
3. If you don't have an account, click the "Create New Account" option.
4. Follow the prompts and provide your personal details. The most important is your email address.
5. Once you've completed the sign up process, you'll need to verify your email address. YouTube will send you a verification email.
6. Once you've verified your account, log into YouTube.



HOW TO UPLOAD VIDEOS

1. Once logged into YouTube, in the top right hand section of your screen, you'll see an icon of a camera with a plus in it. Click on this icon.
2. Select Upload Video
3. Select the video you wish to upload
4. Enter a Title for your video and keep it easy to remember, searchable and easy to read.
5. Enter a Description for your video - this lets viewers know what the video is all about.
6. Follow the prompts to enter more details about your video.
7. Click Next
8. Confirm your video elements
9. Click Next
10. Decide how and when you'd like to publish your video and make the corresponding selection.
11. Click Publish and your video will start to upload to YouTube.
12. You'll be provided a YouTube link that will allow you to see your video once it's been published.
13. You can make edits to your video title, description and other details in the editor studio section of YouTube.
